Subject: Amendments to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Monaco from 3 to 7 November 2014 at its 83rd session:

HAVING REGARD TO Articles 26, 36 and 44 of the Organization's Constitution,

CONSIDERING Resolution AG-2011-RES-07, adopted by the General Assembly at its 80th session (2011, Hanoi), adopting INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data,

BEARING IN MIND Resolution AG-2002-RES-09, adopted by the General Assembly at its 71st session (2002, Yaoundé), establishing the Working Group on the Processing of Information and tasking the Group with revising the rules relating to the processing of police information,

MINDFUL OF the need to adapt INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data in the light of current practice, given the developments in the processing of data for the purposes of international police cooperation,

TAKING NOTE OF the opinion of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files in accordance with Article 36, paragraph 2 of the Constitution,

HAVING NOTED the opinion of the ad hoc Committee set up in application of Article 56 of the Organization's General Regulations,

RECALLING that, under the terms of Article 8 of INTERPOL's Constitution, the General Assembly is empowered to determine any regulations deemed necessary,

ENDORSES the proposed amendments to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data contained in Report AG-2014-RAP-01 submitted by the Working Group on the Processing of Information (GTI);

THANKS the Working Group on the Processing of Information (GTI) for its work;

APPROVES INTERPOL's amended Rules on the Processing of Data, as set out in Appendix 2 of Report AG-2014-RAP-01;

DECIDES that the relevant amendments shall enter into force immediately;

ASKS the General Secretariat to ensure that these amendments are implemented.
