Case details: CLAMPARU is accused of heading a human trafficking network which between 2000 and 2004 is thought to have resulted in more than 100 Romanian women being forced into prostitution in Spain. CLAMPARU and his associates organised papers and travel plans for the girls who had been offered 'real' jobs, with the girls agreeing to refund the expenses from their wages. However, upon arrival in Spain it is alleged that they were beaten and forced to work as prostitutes to 'repay' the transport costs. In 2004, 14 members of CLAMPARU's crime network were captured and tried. It is suspected that CLAMPARU is still involved in the trafficking of women from Romania to western European countries.

CLAMPARU has travelled extensively throughout Europe including Romania, Spain, Italy and France and the UK and is believed to still be in the region, possibly in the Netherlands or Spain. He is thought to have connections with prostitution rings in tourist destinations, nightclubs and hotels and may have established contacts in Ireland and the UK.
