TEXT OF THE RESOLUTION

HAVING TAKEN NOTE of Report No.13, entitled "Draft Convention for the suppression of international traffic in unlawfully obtained property",

CONVINCED of the need to improve international co-operation to combat international traffic in unlawfully obtained property,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Cannes from 18th to 25th October 1983 at its 52nd session:

RECOMMENDS that NCBs submit the above-mentioned Report to their Governments so that the latter may assess the advisability of taking steps to adopt an international convention along the lines of the draft prepared by the ICPO-Interpol and comment on the provisions of this draft.

REQUESTS that NCBs transmit to the ICPO-Interpol General Secretariat the observations of their Governments relating to the above-mentioned draft, before the 53rd General Assembly session.
