TEXT OF RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the international traffic in illicit narcotic drugs continues to be a matter of global concern,

NOTING that prior annual General Assembly conferences have also devoted considerable discussions to the matter of this highly organized criminal activity and the concomitant detrimental consequences of addiction,

CONSIDERING that the General Assembly at its 29th session in Washington adopted a resolution recommending that all members of the ICPO-Interpol urge on their governments the necessity of providing for severe prison sentences for convicted drug traffickers, if the legislation existing is inadequate,

FURTHER CONSIDERING that the General Assembly at its 30th session in Copenhagen adopted a resolution recommending that member countries having a drug addiction problem and the economic means to do so, provide facilities for civil commitment in suitable centres for the treatment of narcotic addiction,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Madrid from 19th to 26th September 1962 at its 31st session:

REQUESTS THE SECRETARY GENERAL to furnish an annual report to be submitted in advance of subsequent meetings of the General Assembly (and for discussion at such meeting) indicating the actions taken and/or the current situation in all member countries, regarding the resolutions cited above.
