TEXT OF RESOLUTION

CONSIDERING the advantages for the members of the Organization of technical assistance particularly in the training of personnel,

NOTING the fact that owing to its lack of funds the Organization cannot, at the present time, increase its possibilities of providing technical assistance for its members.

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Washington from 10th to 15th October 1960 at its 29th session:

SUGGESTS that the Secretary General try to reach this goal as the means placed at the disposal of the Organization increase in future years;

ASKS the Secretary General:

- (a) to contact the proper agencies of the United Nations in the near future in order to learn if and under what conditions, that Organization might finance a police technical assistance program which would be carried out by ICPO-Interpol;
- (b) to find out as soon as possible from all the NCBs what technical possibilities are offered from different countries for the training of personnel or the supplying of experts and to make this information available to the countries which might request it.
