

## **Resolution No. 2**

GA-2019-88-RES-02

**Subject:** Amendments to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Santiago de Chile from 15 to 18 October 2019 at its 88th session:

HAVING REGARD to Articles 26, 36 and 44 of the Organization's Constitution,

CONSIDERING Resolution AG-2011-RES-07, adopted by the General Assembly at its 80th session (Hanoi, 2011), adopting INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data,

COGNIZANT of the importance of ensuring that the Rules continue to serve the requirements of INTERPOL's Members and remain effective, easily implementable, and up-to-date with the latest developments in international criminal data processing and the Organization's activities,

BEARING IN MIND Resolution AG-2002-RES-09, adopted by the General Assembly at its 71st session (Yaoundé, 2002), establishing the Working Group on the Processing of Information (GTI) and tasking the Group with revising the rules relating to the processing of information,

CONSIDERING Resolution GA-2018-87-RES-08, adopted by the General Assembly at its 87th session (Dubai, 2018), launching a general review of INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data and tasking the Working Group on the Processing of Information (GTI) with this review,

TAKING NOTE of the opinion of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files in accordance with Article 36, paragraph 2 of the Constitution,

HAVING NOTED the opinion of the ad hoc Committee set up in application of Article 56 of the Organization's General Regulations,

RECALLING that, under the terms of Article 8 of INTERPOL's Constitution, the General Assembly is empowered to determine any regulations deemed necessary,

ENDORSES the proposed amendments to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data contained in Report GA-2019-88-REP-01 submitted by the Working Group on the Processing of Information (GTI);

THANKS the Working Group on the Processing of Information (GTI) for its work;

APPROVES INTERPOL's amended Rules on the Processing of Data, as set out in Appendix 3 of Report GA-2019-88-REP-01;

DECIDES that the amendments shall enter into force immediately;

REQUESTS the Working Group on the Processing of Information (GTI) to continue its general review of INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data and to report on its progress to the General Assembly at its coming sessions.
