Subject: Enhancement of INTERPOL's Defined Contribution Pension Scheme

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in New Delhi from 18 to 21 October 2022 at its 90th session:

CONSIDERING Resolution AG-2004-RES-21, adopted by the General Assembly at its 73rd session (Cancun, 2004),

ALSO CONSIDERING the Rules of the Organization's Pension Scheme approved by the Executive Committee at its 147th session (Berlin, 2005),

FURTHER CONSIDERING Report GA-2022-90-REP-21 setting out the rationale for the enhancement of the Organization's Defined Contribution Pension Scheme,

ACKNOWLEDGING that the enhancement of the Defined Contribution Pension Scheme shall aim at its increased financial sustainability in the middle and long-term,

NOTING the support expressed by the Advisory Group on Financial Matters and the Executive Committee to the proposal to enhance the INTERPOL's Defined Contribution Pension Scheme in the interests of the officials and the Organization,

APPROVES the proposal to enhance the INTERPOL's Defined Contribution Pension Scheme in accordance with the fundamental principles and objectives set out in Report GA-2022-90-REP-21;

TASKS the General Secretariat to propose draft amendments to INTERPOL's legal framework applicable to the Defined Contribution Pension Scheme at its 91st session;

FURTHER TASKS the General Secretariat to regularly consult with the Advisory Group on Financial Matters and the Executive Committee on the significant legal and financial matters concerning the Defined Contribution Pension Scheme.
