

## **Resolution No. 9**

GA-2024-92-RES-09

**Subject:** Report of the Working Group to Review Legal Provisions Relating to INTERPOL's Governing Bodies – Amendments to Article 18 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Glasgow, United Kingdom, from 4 to 7 November 2024, at its 92nd session:

RECALLING Resolution GA-2018-87-RES-15, on the establishment of a Working Group to Review Legal Provisions Relating to INTERPOL's Governing Bodies ("Working Group on Governance"), and Resolution GA-2023-91-RES-04, tasking the Working Group on Governance to submit a progress report on its new programme of work to the General Assembly at its 92nd session and to submit, if necessary, further proposals for reform pertaining to INTERPOL's governing bodies,

HAVING CONSIDERED the proposal by the Executive Committee to the Working Group on Governance on seating the host country at the first place as a mark of respect,

HAVING CONSIDERED Report GA-2024-92-REP-01, submitted by the Working Group on Governance, pertaining to the seating arrangement of member countries at INTERPOL's General Assembly sessions,

HAVING NOTED the opinion of the ad hoc Committee set up in application of Article 56 of the Organization's General Regulations,

APPROVES all of the amendments to Article 18 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly, as set out in paragraph 8 of Report GA-2024-92-REP-01;

DECIDES that the aforementioned amendments shall enter into force immediately, following the close of the 92nd session of the General Assembly.
