Subject: Endorsement of a feasibility study on the creation of a Strategic Studies Centre

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Beijing, China, from 26 to 29 September 2017, at its 86th session:

CONSIDERING the volatile and complex global security landscape that generates ever-increasing threats,

ACKNOWLEDGING the efforts of the Executive Committee and the General Secretariat to develop a more future-oriented approach towards international police cooperation,

RECOGNIZING the need for member countries and the General Secretariat to have a more in-depth understanding of the current global security landscape,

CONSIDERING that INTERPOL should be supported by a strategic foresight capability in order to make well-informed decisions,

ENDORSES the proposal to embark on a strategic studies programme which will include a research platform to facilitate INTERPOL's strategic decision-making;

TASKS the General Secretariat, with the guidance of the Executive Committee, to conduct a feasibility study on the creation of a Strategic Studies Centre, including a sustainable funding mechanism.
