<u>Subject</u>: Draft Arrangement on Cooperation between the International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL and the United Nations in relation to direct access by United Nations Department of Safety and Security to the INTERPOL Information System (supplementary to the Cooperation Agreement between the International Criminal

Police Organization – INTERPOL and the United Nations)

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Monaco, from 3 to 7 November 2014 at its 83rd session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 41 of the Organization's Constitution,

CONVINCED of the need to further develop the cooperation between INTERPOL and the United Nations in relation to crime prevention and criminal justice, specifically in relation enhancing the ability to trace lost or stolen United Nations Laissez-Passers, and stolen United Nations motor vehicles,

BEARING IN MIND INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data,

HAVING EXAMINED Report No. AG-2014-RAP-17,

DEEMING that the Draft Cooperation Arrangement at Appendix 1 to Report No. AG-2014-RAP-17 is in conformity with the Organization's interests and rules,

CONSIDERING that, under the terms of Article 41 of the Constitution and Article 27 of INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data, this Agreement shall only be binding on the Organization after its approval by the General Assembly,

APPROVES the Draft Cooperation Arrangement contained at Appendix 1 to Report No. AG-2014-RAP-17.
