AG-2014-RES-07

<u>Subject</u>: Draft Cooperation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL and the Maritime Analysis and Operation Centre – Narcotics (MAOC-N)

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Monaco from 3 to 7 November 2014 at its 83rd session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 41 of the Organization's Constitution,

RECALLING that the Maritime Analysis and Operation Centre – Narcotics serves as a recognized organization to cooperate in the suppression of illicit drug trafficking by sea and by air,

NOTING that MAOC-N seeks to support and complement INTERPOL's existing activity in this crime area,

RECOGNIZING that MAOC-N is an operational platform established by seven member countries of the European Union (France, Ireland, Italy, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain and United Kingdom),

HAVING EXAMINED Report AG-2014-RAP-16 which proposes a draft Cooperation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL and MAOC-N,

NOTING that the desired outcome of the Cooperation Agreement is to exchange intelligence in order to enhance the fight against illicit drug trafficking,

CONSIDERING that INTERPOL is pursuing the goal of developing enhanced cooperation with other international and regional organizations,

DEEMING that the draft Cooperation Agreement given at Appendix 1 to Report AG-2014-RAP-16 is in conformity with the Organization's interests and rules,

APPROVES the draft Cooperation Agreement given at Appendix 1 to Report AG-2014-RAP-16;

AUTHORIZES the Secretary General to sign it.
