## RESOLUTION

<u>Subject</u>: Draft Cooperation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization - INTERPOL and the Netherlands Police Agency, Korps landelijke politiediensten (KLPD) – Providing INTERPOL member countries with access to the EdisonTD genuine travel documents database

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Rome, Italy, from 5 to 8 November 2012 at its 81st session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 41 of the Organization's Constitution,

CONSIDERING that a great number or variety of different travel documents, or versions thereof, issued by a given country and in circulation at the same time, is likely to create confusion and uncertainty among officials of other countries examining such documents,

AWARE that the detection and interception of counterfeit, altered or stolen travel documents depends to a great extent on accurate and timely information being received from a given country's issuing authorities,

RECOGNIZING the need to use information on genuine, stolen and lost travel documents in order to detect, apprehend, and limit the movement of terrorists, fugitives, and other criminals who use fraudulent travel documents,

HAVING EXAMINED Report AG-2012-RAP-08 which sets out a Draft Cooperation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization - INTERPOL and the Netherlands Police Agency, Korps landelijke politiediensten (KLPD),

DEEMING that the Draft Cooperation Agreement given at Appendix 1 to Report AG-2012-RAP-08 conforms to the Organization's interest and rules,

APPROVES the Draft Cooperation Agreement given at Appendix 1 to Report AG-2012-RAP-08;

AUTHORIZES the Secretary General to sign it.
