RESOLUTION

<u>Subject</u>: Enhancing international police co-operation by providing INTERPOL's International Police Training Programme (IIPTP) to a wider range of police officers worldwide and calling more member countries to participate in the programme

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Singapore from 11 to 15 October 2009, at its 78th session:

CONSIDERING the importance of the training programme in enhancing international police co-operation,

BEARING IN MIND that Police Training and Development is INTERPOL's fourth core function,

NOTING that international police training is necessary to combat international crime,

ACKNOWLEDGING that a large number of INTERPOL member countries have already benefited from the programme,

CONVINCED that the programme supports international police co-operation,

ENCOURAGES member countries to raise awareness of the programme and to invite police services involved in international co-operation which have never participated in the programme to submit applications.
