RESOLUTION

Subject: Operation INFRA-RED

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Singapore from 11 to 15 October 2009 at its 78th session:

BEARING IN MIND Articles 2, 26 and 31 of INTERPOL's Constitution,

ACKNOWLEDGING that the location and apprehension of fugitives is a priority supported by INTERPOL and the international community as a whole,

MINDFUL of the differing national laws and international treaties governing the apprehension and extradition of fugitives,

CONCERNED about the pervasive threat posed by Fugitives to public safety and to the efficiency of criminal justice systems worldwide,

RECOGNIZING the need to update INTERPOL Red notices with new information that can assist in the location and apprehension of fugitives worldwide,

CONVINCED that success in the fight to bring international fugitives to justice is dependent upon international co-operation,

ENCOURAGES all Member countries, through their National Central Bureaus to ensure the widest possible mutual assistance in order to apprehend the international fugitives who might be residing in their respective country;

URGES relevant law enforcement entities, including specialist fugitive units in Member Countries to consider participating in a dedicated international fugitive operation such as INFRA-RED;

REQUESTS the General Secretariat to assist INTERPOL Member countries where necessary in order to realise the apprehension of the fugitives, including the production and dissemination of information and photographs of the fugitives and provide co-ordination and operational support.
