## **RESOLUTION**

<u>Subject</u>: Draft Cooperation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL and the Central Asian Regional Information and Coordination Centre for combating illicit trafficking of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors (CARICC)

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Hanoi, Vietnam, from 31 October to 3 November 2011 at its 80th session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 41 of the Organization's Constitution,

CONSIDERING the Resolution adopted by INTERPOL's General Assembly at its 75th session held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, in 2006, supporting regional policing initiatives and highlighting the importance of INTERPOL cooperating with regional organizations operating in the law enforcement field by signing cooperation agreements with them,

RECOGNIZING INTERPOL's role of assistance to its member countries in fighting illicit drug trafficking, which is one of the Organization's priority crime areas,

AWARE OF CARICC's mandate to facilitate information exchange and analysis, and to assist in the coordination of operational activities of the various law enforcement agencies in the region and thereby improve effectiveness in combating illicit trafficking of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors,

HAVING EXAMINED Report AG-2011-RAP-08 which sets out a Draft Cooperation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL and the Central Asian Regional Information and Coordination Centre,

DEEMING that the Draft Cooperation Agreement given at Appendix 1 to Report AG-2011-RAP-08 conforms to the Organization's interests and rules,

APPROVES the Draft Cooperation Agreement given at Appendix 1 to Report AG-2011-RAP-08;

AUTHORIZES the Secretary General to sign it.
