Subject: References to national laws in Interpol resolutions

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting at its 71st session in Yaoundé, from 21 to 24 October 2002:

NOTING THE CONTENTS of Report AG-2002-RAP-07 "References to National Laws in Interpol resolutions", submitted by the General Secretariat,

REAFFIRMS the importance of guaranteeing the national sovereignty of Member States, as set out in Article 2 of the Interpol Constitution;

APPROVES the recommendations of the above report with the aim of harmonizing references to national laws in Interpol resolutions.
