

RESOLUTION

Subject: New system of statutory contributions - Distribution of contributions

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Budapest from 24 to 28 September 2001 at its 70th session:

NOTING THE CONTENTS OF Report AG-2001-RAP-02, entitled "Amendments to the Financial Regulations - Implementing rules for the new system of contributions - Improvements to the Organization's financial management system",

TAKING NOTE OF the recommendations formulated by the Group of Experts on Statutory Contributions,

BEARING IN MIND the principle of distributing contributions on the basis of Members' ability to pay, as laid down in the Financial Regulations of the Organization,

CONSIDERING it necessary to detail how statutory contributions should be distributed in application of the above principle,

RECALLING Resolution AGN/67/RES/5, which established the Special Allocations Fund intended to cover expenditure which exceeds budget allocations and to allow the allocation of the donations paid into the Fund in accordance with the conditions specified by those who had paid the donations, unless those donors agree to the donation being used for another purpose,

PAYS TRIBUTE to the Group of Experts on Statutory Contributions, which it thanks for its work concerned with the implementation of the new system of contributions and which was likely to improve the functioning of the Organization;

ENDORSES the distribution of contributions discussed and negotiated by the six main contributors;

DECIDES that:

- contributions paid by member countries which are members of the OECD shall remain at least at the same percentage as at the time of adoption of the present Resolution;
- the minimum contribution shall be fixed at 0.03% of the budget;

- the contributions of other members countries will be distributed on the basis of a pro rata application of the UN scale of contributions, adopted as a reference on the date when the scale of contributions is approved or revised;

ALSO DECIDES:

- that the scale of contributions will be revised by the General Assembly every three years and will remain valid until the following revision;
- to delegate to the Executive Committee the authority to adjust the scale of contributions in accordance with the rules laid down in the present Resolution if a country joins or leaves the Organization; if increased or reduced membership were to result in a variation of 5% or more in the total amount to be distributed, the Executive Committee would have to inform the General Assembly, so that the latter could revise the entire scale;

FURTHER DECIDES that:

- the new system of contributions shall be gradually introduced over a period of five years from 2002 to 2006 inclusive, and that the scale shall be revised for the first time at the end of the transition period;
- the scale of contributions attached as an Appendix to the present Resolution shall be gradually introduced during the transition period; in this respect, the increase borne by the countries concerned will benefit first and foremost those countries which will eventually be paying the minimum contribution;
- for the purposes of establishing a scale applicable until the end of the transition period, reference is made to the UN scale for 2001, as approved by the UN General Assembly in Resolution A/RES/55/5B-F, adopted on 23 December 2000;

URGES those countries whose contributions are expected to fall under the new system but who are able to maintain their contributions at the current level to do so;

DECIDES that voluntary contributions paid by Members will be paid into the Special Allocations Fund, established by Resolution AGN/67/RES/5;

DECIDES, to that effect, that Interpol's Special Allocations Fund may receive voluntary contributions paid by member countries.
