### **TEXT OF THE RESOLUTION**

HAVING TAKEN NOTE of Report No. 7, entitled "Modification of the Rules on International Police Co-operation and on the Internal Control of Interpol's Archives",

HAVING TAKEN NOTE of the views of the "ad hoc" Committee consulted in application of Article 56 of the General Regulations,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Ottawa from 27th September to 3rd October 1990 at its 59th session:

DECIDES to add a paragraph to Article 7 of the Rules on International Police Co-operation and on the Internal Control of Interpol's Archives, to read as follows (the present paragraph 4 becoming paragraph 5):

"(4) A National Central Bureau or official institution which communicates police information to the General Secretariat may expressly ask the General Secretariat not to disclose an item of information or its source to anyone. In such cases, the General Secretariat must comply with the restriction and inform the National Central Bureau or official institution which communicated the information that it has received an enquiry to which the item concerned might respond. At the request of the institution which communicated the information, the General Secretariat shall reply to the requesting institution stating that no information relevant to the request is available.";

DECIDES that the words "subject to the provisions of Article 7(4)" shall be inserted at the end of the third sentence of Article 8(1), after the words "requesting NCB";

DECIDES that the amendment to Article 7 of the said Rules shall enter into force on a date to be determined by the Executive Committee.
