TEXT OF RESOLUTION

HAVING TAKEN NOTE of the message delivered by Mr. François Mitterrand, President of the French Republic, on the occasion of the inauguration of Interpol's new Headquarters in Lyons on 27th November 1989,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Lyons from 27th November to 1st December 1989 at its 58th session:

ASKS the General Secretariat to conduct a feasibility study on the purpose and mission of an international establishment for the training of police officers, especially those from developing countries, to combat all forms of crime and to report to the ICPO-Interpol General Assembly at its next session, having kept the Executive Committee regularly informed of all developments in the matter.
