TEXT OF RESOLUTION

NOTING that seizures of drugs are taking place over a wider area and
are increasing in volume;

CONCERNED by the increase in drug abuse by young persons;

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Frankfurt from 19th to
26th September 1972 at its 41st session:

URGES all countries:

1) To take all possible steps to detect and destroy illicit crops and
clandestine laboratories manufacturing drugs;

2) To make arrangements for sound training for the enforcement officials
of their countries in detection and investigation of drug crimes;

3) In respect of illicit drug traffic, to promote better exchange of information between the countries concerned through the ICPO-INTERPOL machinery;

4) To apply strict controls on production, manufacture, trade and sale of drugs so as to limit their use to medical and scientific needs and to avoid their being diverted to illicit channels for drug abuse;

WOULD APPRECIATE that the United Nations publish the facts it has collected about the dangers of misuse of drugs, so as to dispel ignorance and remove prejudices in regard to drug abuse.
