TEXT OF RESOLUTION

NOTING that the theft of goods in seaports and airports may have international origins, implications or ramifications;

CONSIDERING that rapid international exchange of information can facilitate investigations, the collection of evidence and the prosecution of offenders;

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Brussels from 5th to 10th October 1970 at its 39th session:

SUGGESTS that the authorities responsible for criminal investigation in seaports and airports contact the appropriate national authorities whenever the co-operation of a foreign police force is required;

URGES the National Central Bureaus to give all possible assistance to any request for help they may receive in this field.
