Subject: INTERPOL Strategic Framework 2022-2025

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Istanbul, Turkey, from 23 to 25 November 2021 at its 89th session:

RECALLING Article 8(b) of INTERPOL's Constitution, according to which the General Assembly shall "determine principles and lay down the general measures suitable for attaining the objectives of the Organization",

BEARING IN MIND the need for INTERPOL to adjust its strategy to an ever-changing global context while pursuing its mission and objectives towards a safer world,

COMMITTED to enhancing its support to INTERPOL's 194 member countries with a view to anticipating new forms of crime and emerging threats,

REFERRING to the insights received through internal and external consultations and from member countries throughout the course of recent years,

TAKING NOTE of the successful completion of the 2017-2020 Strategic Framework and the support expressed by member countries over the past four years,

CONSIDERING that the Executive Committee has endorsed the INTERPOL Strategic Framework 2022-2025,

APPROVES the INTERPOL Strategic Framework 2022-2025 and SUPPORTS its implementation over the next four years;

ENDORSES INTERPOL's new strategic architecture, which comprises the Strategic Framework 2022-2025 as the overarching strategic direction of the Organization.

Adopted
