Subject: Remuneration of the members of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Glasgow, United Kingdom, from 4 to 7 November 2024 at its 92nd session:

HAVING EXAMINED Report GA-2024-92-REP-20 entitled "Remuneration of the members of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files",

MINDFUL of the importance of ensuring that the processing of data in the INTERPOL Information System complies with INTERPOL's rules – in particular with Articles 2(1) and 2(3) of the Constitution – as well as with the principles of international law,

ACKNOWLEDGING the important work performed by the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files pursuant to Article 36 of the Constitution,

RECALLING Article 13 of the Statute of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files,

CONSIDERING that the remuneration of the members of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files has been included in the overall annual budget as outlined in Report GA-2024-92-REP-15 entitled "Programme of Activities and Draft Budget for 2025, and Indications for 2026 and 2027",

GIVES its approval for:

- An annual allowance of EUR 40,000 instead of EUR 20,000 for the CCF members;
- A maximum of 80 days of work for each member of the Commission per annum instead of 26 days, at the same rate of EUR 600 per day;
- A maximum of 125 days of work for the Chairperson of the Commission, starting in 2026.

Adopted: 90 votes in favour, 36 against, 4 abstentions
