Subject: Amendments to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data and the Statute of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Marrakech, Morocco, from 24 to 27 November 2025, at its 93rd session:

RECALLING that, under the terms of Article 8 of INTERPOL's Constitution, the General Assembly is empowered to determine any regulations deemed necessary,

CONSIDERING Resolution AG-2011-RES-07, adopted by the General Assembly at its 80th session (Hanoi, Vietnam, 31 October – 3 November 2011), adopting INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data,

ALSO CONSIDERING Resolution AG-2016-RES-06, adopted by the General Assembly at its 85th session (Bali, Indonesia, 7-10 November 2016), adopting the Statute of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files,

COGNIZANT of the importance of ensuring that the Rules on the Processing of Data continue to serve the requirements of INTERPOL's Members and remain effective, easily implementable, and up to date with the latest developments in international criminal data processing and the Organization's activities,

CONSCIOUS of the important work performed by the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files pursuant to Article 36 of the Constitution, and of the need to ensure that the Commission's legal framework and procedures enable it to fully exercise its functions,

FURTHER CONSIDERING Resolution GA-2019-88-RES-03, adopted by the General Assembly at its 88th session (Santiago, Chile, 15-18 October 2019), establishing the Committee on the Processing of Data (CPD) and entrusting it with the review of INTERPOL's rules governing the processing of data,

HAVING CONSIDERED Report GA-2025-93-REP-03, submitted by the CPD, on the progress made, and submitting the CPD's proposed amendments to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data and the Statute of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files,

EXPRESSES ITS APPRECIATION to the CPD for its commitment and for the work accomplished;

APPROVES the deletion of Article 94 of INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data, as set out in Appendix 1 of Report GA-2025-93-REP-03;

APPROVES the amendments to Articles 3, 19, 23, 25, 28, and 33 of the Statute of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files, as set out Appendix 1 of Report GA-2025-93-REP-03;

DECIDES that the amendments to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data and the Statute of the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files set out in Appendix 1 of the above-mentioned report shall enter into force immediately at the close of the 93rd session of the General Assembly;

REQUESTS that the CPD continue its review of INTERPOL's rules relating to the processing of data, report on its progress and submit, as deemed appropriate, further proposals for amendments to INTERPOL's rules to the General Assembly at its coming sessions;

INVITES INTERPOL's Members to participate in and contribute to the work of the CPD.
