

THE ROLE OF THE REQUESTS CHAMBER

In practice, the Commission handles two categories of individual requests through its Request Chamber:

- Requests from individuals or entities seeking information on the possible processing of data concerning them in INTERPOL's Information System, also called requests for access;
- Requests from individuals or entities seeking to correct and or delete data recorded in INTERPOL's files concerning them, also called complaints.
