RESOLUTION

<u>Subject</u>: Draft Arrangement on Co-operation between the International Criminal Police Organization-INTERPOL and the United Nations in relation to the United Nations Security Council Sanctions Committees supplementary arrangement to the Co-operation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization-INTERPOL and the United Nations

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Singapore, from 11 to 15 October 2009, at its 78th session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 41 of the Organization's Constitution,

RECALLING its Resolutions Nos. AG-2005-RES-05 (Berlin) and AG-2006-RES-22 (Rio de Janeiro) which tasked the INTERPOL General Secretariat with devising the most efficient ways for the Organization to support – when possible and consistent with the independence and neutrality of the Organization – the co-operation between the United Nations and INTERPOL in order to provide the United Nations Security Council's Sanctions Committees with better tools to fulfill their mandates more effectively,

BEARING IN MIND the exchanges of letters of 8 December 2005 and 5 January 2006, and of 28 and 29 December 2006 respectively, which supplemented the Co-operation Agreement dated 8 July 1997 between INTERPOL and the United Nations,

CONVINCED of the need to further develop the co-operation between INTERPOL and the United Nations in relation to the United Nations Security Council Sanctions Committees,

BEARING IN MIND INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Information for the Purposes of International Police Co-operation and the Rules Governing Access by an Intergovernmental Organization to the INTERPOL Telecommunications network and Databases,

HAVING EXAMINED Report No. AG-2009-RAP-24 which sets out a Draft Arrangement on Co-operation between the International Criminal Police Organization-INTERPOL and the United Nations in relation to the United Nations Security Council Sanctions Committees supplementary to the Co-operation Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization-INTERPOL and the United Nations,

DEEMING that the Draft Arrangement at Appendix 1 to Report No. AG-2009-RAP-24 is in conformity with the Organization's interests and rules,

CONSIDERING that, under the terms of Article 41 of the Constitution and the Rules governing access by an intergovernmental organization to the INTERPOL telecommunications network and databases, this Agreement shall only be binding on the Organization after its approval by the General Assembly,

APPROVES the Draft Co-operation Arrangement contained at Appendix 1 to Report No. AG-2009-RAP-24.
