### **TEXT OF RESOLUTION**

IN VIEW OF Interpol's need to have the maximum possible attendance at its meetings,

NOTING the unfortunate absence of some of the most involved countries at recent Interpol meetings,

AWARE that these absences were mostly due to lack of finance,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Beijing from 4th to 10th October 1995 at its 64th session:

ASKS the Secretary General to explore methods of obtaining funds to assist member countries, particularly developing and least developed countries, with financial problems to participate in Interpol meetings, bearing in mind that the Organization's budget does not allow for the funding of the attendance of delegates of member countries at Interpol meetings.
