TEXT OF RESOLUTION

HAVING STUDIED Report No. 18, entitled "Fingerprint transmission form and latent transmission for search request form", submitted by the General Secretariat,

NOTING the need to provide high-quality images together with adequate accompanying information to process fingerprint comparisons, whether manually or by using computerized systems,

RECOGNIZING the need to transmit fingerprints and latents between ICPO-Interpol member countries for the investigation of crime,

RECALLING the decisions taken by the 20th European Regional Conference (1991) on the setting up of a Working Party to study the standardization of fingerprint forms and the possible standardization of fingerprint procedures which would allow them to be processed by national automated fingerprint identification systems and thus promote international co-operation, and mindful of the recommendation made by the 1st International Symposium on Fingerprinting and Fingerprint Standards (18th and 19th May 1995),

HAVING TAKEN NOTE of the work already done by the Interpol European Working Party on Fingerprint Standards, in particular:

- (1) The study and design of a standard form and accompanying document for the transmission of fingerprints between European countries, and acceptance of these documents by the 22nd European Regional Conference (1993),
- (2) The design of a standard European form for latent transmission and search requests, and its acceptance by the 24th European Regional Conference (1995),

RESOLUTION No. AGN/64/RES/9

CONVINCED of the importance of using a standard fingerprint transmission form and latent transmission for search request form on a worldwide basis in order to promote international co-operation,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Beijing from 4th to 10th October 1995 at its 64th session:

RECOMMENDS that National Central Bureaus use these forms for transmitting fingerprints and latent prints between the Organization's member countries.
