TEXT OF RESOLUTION

NOTING THE CONTENTS of Report No. 20, entitled "Organization of Interpol General Assembly sessions",

CONSCIOUS of the need to formalize the conditions under which General Assembly sessions are organized by defining the respective obligations of the host country and of the ICPO-Interpol,

WISHING to have available a model agreement specifying the guarantees a host country should grant to delegates and General Secretariat staff participating in a General Assembly session in respect of their entry to and exit from the country and their stay in that country during the session, and should also grant to enable the session to proceed smoothly,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Antalya from 23rd to 29th October 1996 at its 65th session:

ADOPTS the documents appended to Report No. 20, entitled "Organization of Interpol General Assembly sessions: Specifications" and "Special Agreement on the ICPO-Interpol's privileges and immunities during the Executive Committee meeting and General Assembly session to be held in ...";

RECOMMENDS that countries wishing to host a General Assembly session make their intentions known at least two years in advance and submit a file on the material arrangements to the Secretary General;

ASKS the Secretary General to report regularly to the Executive Committee on the state of preparations for each forthcoming General Assembly session.
