TEXT OF RESOLUTION

HAVING CONSIDERED Report No. 2, submitted by the Executive Committee and entitled "Amending the Organization's Constitution: Voting conditions (Amendment of Article 52 of the General Regulations)",

HAVING TAKEN NOTE of the opinion of the ad hoc Committee set up in application of Article 56 of the General Regulations,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Antalya from 23rd to 29th October 1996 at its 65th session:

APPROVES the above report and DECIDES that a paragraph, reading as follows, should be added to Article 52 of the General Regulations:

"The voting restrictions provided for in the present Article shall not apply to votes taken on proposed amendments to the Organization's Constitution."

ASKS the Executive Committee to adapt the above paragraph to the wording of the new Article 52 of the General Regulations, if necessary.
