TEXT OF RESOLUTION

BEARING IN MIND Resolution AGN/64/RES/11 (Beijing, 1995), which recommended that co-operation agreements be concluded with international organizations useful to international police co-operation,

HAVING EXAMINED Report No. 6 entitled "Draft Memoranda of Understanding with the World Customs Organization and with the Arab Interior Ministers' Council",

RECOGNIZING the advantages of formalizing relations between the ICPO-Interpol and the WCO in an agreement which would ensure improved co-ordination of the fight against international crime, thus avoiding duplication of effort,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Cairo from 22nd to 27th October 1998 at its 67th session:

APPROVES the Memorandum of Understanding with the WCO appended to Report No. 6 (Appendix 1);

INSTRUCTS the Secretary General to conclude specific arrangements to permit the exchange of criminal information in strict conformity with the Organization's internal regulations;

AUTHORIZES the Secretary General to sign it.
