

RESOLUTION

Subject: Establishment of an Interpol Sub-Regional Bureau for Central America
in San Salvador, El Salvador

ENDORSING the recommendation of the 16th American Regional Conference, meeting in May 1999 in San Salvador, relating to the establishment of the Interpol Sub-Regional Bureau for Central America in San Salvador,

TAKING NOTE of the formal offer made by the Republic of El Salvador to host such an Interpol Sub-Regional Bureau,

CONVINCED that the establishment of such a Sub-Regional Bureau would be of benefit to the countries in the Central America region in particular, and the Organization's Member States in general,

RECALLING that the Sub-Regional Bureau for Central America, like the other Interpol Sub-Regional Bureaux, shall work in accordance with the Organization's internal regulations as well as the regionalization policy principles,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Seoul from 8th to 13th November 1999 at its 68th session:

THANKS the Government of the Republic of El Salvador for its offer to host an Interpol Sub-Regional Bureau for Central America;

ACCEPTS the principle of establishing the Sub-Regional Bureau for Central America in San Salvador;

RECALLS that the host country is responsible for providing the premises and administrative support costs for the Sub-Regional Bureau and that the countries of the region will be required to provide personnel and contribute to running costs;

AUTHORIZES the Secretary General to negotiate a draft Headquarters Agreement for the Sub-Regional Bureau with the authorities of El Salvador, and

ASKS the Secretary General to submit a final text of the Draft Agreement to the General Assembly for approval.
