TEXT OF RESOLUTION

WISHING TO THANK Members of the Executive Committee for their excellent work,

ALSO WISHING TO EMPHASIZE the dedication and competence which they have demonstrated in the accomplishment of their difficult tasks,

FURTHER WISHING TO HIGHLIGHT the importance the Organization continues to attach to Executive Committee Members even after their terms of office have expired,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Rome from 28th September to 4th October 1994 at its 63rd session:

DECIDES, as a token of the esteem in which it holds Executive Committee Members, to confer honorary titles on them at the end of their terms of office;

CONSEQUENTLY DECLARES that, at the Executive Committee's proposal, former Members of the Committee may be authorized to avail themselves of the titles of, where appropriate, Honorary President, Vice-President or Member of the Executive Committee, until the start of the third General Assembly session following the one at which their mandate terminates;

AUTHORIZES the Executive Committee, under exceptional circumstances, to strip former Executive Committee Members of their honorary titles, in the event that the Committee considers their positions are no longer in keeping with the honour bestowed.
