### **TEXT OF RESOLUTION**

HAVING EXAMINED Report No. 19 entitled "The National Central Bureaus of the ICPO-Interpol: Policy",

HAVING TAKEN NOTE of the opinion of the Ad Hoc Committee consulted in conformity with Article 56 of the General Regulations,

BEARING IN MIND Articles 31-33 of the Organization's Constitution which call for the appointment by each member country of a body to serve as the National Central Bureau,

RECOGNISING the importance of the role of the National Central Bureaus in the context of international police co-operation,

BELIEVING that for National Central Bureaus to be effective and for them to meet the needs of international police co-operation, they should strive to attain agreed standards of performance,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Rome from 28th September to 4th October 1994 at its 63rd session:

DECIDES that the document "The National Central Bureaus of the ICPO-Interpol: Policy", adopted by the 34th General Assembly session of the ICPO-Interpol, should be deleted as an Appendix to the General Regulations;

APPROVES and ADOPTS Report No. 19 "The National Central Bureaus of the ICPO-Interpol: Policy" as a set of policy guidelines.
