### **TEXT OF RESOLUTION**

CONSIDERING the work of the First International Conference on Fraudulent Travel Documents meeting in Ottawa in April 1992 and the recommendations drafted by the Working Group,

NOTING the great interest expressed by the delegates of the First International Conference on Fraudulent Travel Documents and the expressed urgent need for more international conferences on fraudulent travel documents in order to solve the problems caused by the increasing use of fraudulent travel documents,

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT the very large number of issues to be considered in the search for solutions concerning the ever-increasing use of fraudulent travel documents by international criminals,

CONSIDERING the expressed intention of the Zimbabwean Delegation to host an interim international conference on fraudulent travel documents in 1994,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Dakar, Senegal from 4th to 10th November 1992 at its 61st session:

RECOMMENDS that, in order to deal with the most pressing matters involving the use of fraudulent travel documents in advance of the international conference planned for Helsinki, Finland in 1997, an interim International Conference on Fraudulent Travel Documents be held during 1994 in Zimbabwe.
