TEXT OF RESOLUTION

NOTING THE CONTENTS of Report No. 11, entitled "Computerization and telecommunications",

BELIEVING that modernization of the ICPO-Interpol's regional telecommunications is of primary importance for the future of international police cooperation,

HAVING BEEN INFORMED of the financial implications of the modernization plan, with regard to both the investment necessary and the related operating costs,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting at its 60th session in Punta del Este from 4th to 8th November 1991:

ADOPTS the modernization plan as described in Report No. 11;

ASKS the Secretary General to seek supplementary sources of finance, such as grants from governments or international organizations with a view to implementing the modernization plan;

ASKS the Secretary General to work out an implementation plan for the modernization of all the regions including the South-East Asian and South Pacific Regions and to make endeavours for its realization.
