TEXT OF RESOLUTION

BEARING IN MIND Resolution AGN/58/RES/14, adopted at its 58th session, concerning an international police training establishment,

DESIROUS of achieving better co-ordination of international police training activities,

CONVINCED of the need to make use of existing national and international training structures rather than create new ones specific to Interpol,

AWARE that training should be regional in scope in order to harmonize programmes and limit costs,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Punta del Este from 4th to 8th November 1991 at its 60th session:

ASKS the General Secretariat:

- to study each region's international police training requirements;
- to seek out those international, regional and national institutions which are already involved in various activities connected with international training for police officers;
- to lay down guidelines for international police training;
- to select various training establishments in the light of the facilities available in each region, in consultation with the institutions concerned;
- to allocate responsibilities among the establishments selected, in consultation with the institutions concerned;
- to assist in meeting police training requirements in each region.
