TEXT OF RESOLUTION

HAVING STUDIED Report No. 9, submitted by the General Secretariat and entitled "Internal Social Insurance Scheme",

HAVING BEEN INFORMED of the fact that the introduction of an internal social insurance scheme is likely to result in significant savings without reducing the level of social insurance cover currently provided for the Organization's agents,

DESIRING that the Organization and its agents employed in France may be exempted from the compulsory French social security system with a view to benefiting from an internal social insurance scheme instituted by the Organization,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Bangkok from 17th to 23rd November 1988 at its 57th session:

APPROVES the "Agreement between the International Criminal Police Organization - Interpol and the Government of the French Republic regarding social insurance cover for the Organization's agents employed on French territory" as it appears in Appendix 1 of the said report;

AUTHORIZES the Secretary General:

- to sign the Exchange of Letters determining the date of entry into force of the said Agreement;
- to sign any Administrative Arrangement made in application of the said Agreement;
- to terminate the said Agreement in the event of this being necessary to protect the Organization's agents concerned against the loss of their social insurance cover;

ASKS the Secretary General to continue to work towards the introduction of an internal social insurance scheme;

REQUESTS the Secretary General to report to the Executive Committee any measures he may have taken in application of the present resolution.
