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TEXT OF RESOLUTION

CONSIDERING the financial consequences of the bomb attack on the Headquarters of the Organization carried out on 16th May 1986,

NOTING that sums paid out by insurance companies in compensation for damage constitute budget receipts,

NOTING also that the cost of repairing such damage must be met from appropriations and Funds, the level of which will consequently be unexpectedly reduced in the course of the financial year,

DESIRING that these appropriations and Funds be readjusted as soon as possible,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Belgrade from 6th to 13th October 1986 at its 55th session:

DECIDES that all sums paid by insurance companies, as compensation for damage suffered by the Organization, shall be automatically assigned to readjusting the appropriations or Funds from which the cost of repairs was met.

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
