TEXT OF RESOLUTION

HAVING HEARD, in the course of the meeting of the Heads of NCBs, the presentation of the Delegate of the Dominican Republic concerning the "migration of offenders to countries where they apply for resident or citizenship status",

HAVING DISCUSSED problems encountered by Member States in co-operating to prevent such migration,

CONVINCED of the value of studying this subject in greater depth, bearing in mind Article 3 of the Constitution,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Washington, D.C. from 1st to 8th October 1985 at its 54th session:

DECIDES:

- To establish a working group to evaluate possibilities of co-operation and exchange of appropriate information on applicants for citizenship or residence with a view to preventing migration of criminals;
- That participation in this working group shall be open to all members.
