TEXT OF RESOLUTION

CONCERNED by the ever-increasing gravity of the problem of illicit traffic in drugs and psychotropic substances in the world today, and by the fact that drug abuse is affecting ever-younger people including adolescents and children, thereby wreaking social havoc,

AWARE that experience has demonstrated the effectiveness of early preventive action, designed to stop people from taking the first steps towards drug consumption, in combating this aspect of the problem and also, by its effect on the demand for drugs, in combating illicit drug traffic in general,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Torremolinos from 5th to 12th October 1982 at its 51st session:

RECOMMENDS that campaigns against the non-medical use of drugs be conducted by specialized multi-disciplinary teams and in liaison with normal drug traffic prevention activities, with a view to safeguarding physical and mental health.
