IN VIEW OF THE FACT THAT rapid action is a basic condition for successful international police co-operation; and

AFTER DUE CONSIDERATION of the suggestions contained in General Secretariat Report No. 14;

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Kyoto from 27th September to 4th October 1967 at its 36th session:

ASKS that the National Central Bureaus adopt the form known as the "dispatch-letter" for corresponding among themselves;

RECOMMENDS that NCBs should follow the instructions set out in Report No. 14 for using dispatch-letters;

ASKS the Secretary General to draw up a suitable model for this type of message and circulate it to the NCBs for their guidance.
