TEXT OF RESOLUTION

HAVING STUDIED Report No. 5 on the international symposia held in 1965 and, in particular, the account of the symposium on the use of electronic data processing by the police, and

IN VIEW OF THE FACT that it would be extremely valuable for departments specialising in the electronic processing of police records if there were at least a minimum degree of international standardisation of the coding of basic, common data about particulars of offenders' appearance and modus operandi;

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Berne from 31st August to 7th September 1966 at its 35th session:

DECIDES to set up a small Committee of Experts to study the possibility of preparing model codes relating to the personal particulars of offenders and their modus operandi, or at least of establishing a basic list of the data that should appear in the codes of all countries;

ASKS the Secretary General to inform the Assembly of the conclusions of this Committee of Experts.
