SUBJECT OF THE CALL FOR BIDS

The International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL with headquarters at 200 quai Charles de Gaulle, 69006 Lyon, France is launching an open call for bids with a view to the conclusion and execution of contract, the objective of which is the provision of a solution (software, hardware components, integration) to collect, store and analyze network traffic and system logs in order to:

- Improve network situation awareness on security aspects;
- Alert on malicious or abnormal behaviors (intrusion, leak of data...);
- Increase proactivity on correcting malfunctioning systems.

As the subject of the consultation is considered as sensitive to the Organization, the present call for tenders shall be divided into two phases:

(i) call for application where all eligible entities may express to INTERPOL their interest to participate in the project by submitting an application according to the submission procedure and

(ii) call for tender where only those entities who have been shortlisted at the end of phase I shall be entitled to submit a bid to answer the Organization's needs as expressed in the Technical Specifications.

All entities whose application is deemed admissible shall be invited to take part in phase II of the procedure.

Starting from Monday 1st of June, documentation relating to this procedure may be requested by sending an email to ao.ab.pcm@interpol.int. The said e-mail shall indicate the name of the entity, name and contact details of the point of contact. The subject of the e-mail shall be: "CONT/3530 - Request for Specifications"

PROCEDURE

1. The submission procedure for phase I shall be requested by email upon selecting the contact link located next to this Call for Tenders on our website

The said e-mail shall contain the indications listed below:

- Subject of the mail: CONT/3530 – Request for Specifications
- Name of the company
- Name, function, telephone number and e-mail of the contact person

The submission procedure will be available from the 1 June 2015 to the 19 June 2015 12:00 (Paris time).

2. Candidates who have requested the submission procedure as described in point 2 will receive an electronic version, in PDF format.
3. The Organization shall receive the applications at its headquarters on the 19 June 2015 at 5:00p.m. (Paris time) at the latest.
4. The Organization intends to draw a short-list of the Bidders whose bid appears to particularly meet the Organization's technical requirements. These Bidders will be invited to participate in interviews taking place at the Organization's headquarters or via videoconference.

The Organization plans to hold the interviews during week <>.
