RESOLUTION

Subject: Headquarters Agreement with France

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Cancún from 5 to 8 October 2004 at its 73rd session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 30 of the Organization's Constitution, whereby all Members of the Organization shall do their best to assist the Secretary General and the staff in the discharge of their functions,

RECALLING the Headquarters Agreement concluded on 3 November 1982 and approved by the General Assembly at its 51st session (Resolution AGN/51/RES/1),

HAVING EXAMINED Report AG-2004-RAP-34 on the negotiations to amend the said Headquarters Agreement in order to improve the Organization's position,

CONSIDERING that the amendments negotiated represent a substantial improvement in the Headquarters Agreement,

CONSIDERING also that it is necessary to pursue the negotiations to obtain satisfaction on the outstanding issues as described in Report AG-2004-RAP-34,

EXPRESSES ITS SINCERE GRATITUDE to France for the new facilities and advantages already granted in the context of the negotiations;

ASKS the Secretary General to continue the negotiations in order to achieve a satisfactory solution to the outstanding issues;

DELEGATES to the Executive Committee, where necessary, the power to approve the amended Headquarters Agreement;

AUTHORIZES the President to sign the amended Headquarters Agreement.
