In the UK, West Ham midfielder Lucas Paqueta faces the possibility of a lifetime ban from soccer due to alleged involvement in a betting scandal, including accusations of intentionally receiving yellow cards to benefit from bets, and has reportedly obstructed the investigation by the English Football Association (FA) after failing to cooperate and claiming he disposed of his confiscated mobile phone.

Trafic de stéroïdes anabolisants dans le Grand Est : cinq hommes condamnés par le tribunal de Verdun

In France, five men, aged 33 to 41, were sentenced by the Verdun correctional court to prison terms ranging from 6 months to 18 months, including 12 months with probation, for trafficking anabolic steroids and growth hormones in gyms in the Grand Est region, having ordered these illegal substances from Eastern European websites between 2021 and 2024.

Stream Teams: Battery Farming Sport For Bets

The following feature article explores 1xBet, a controversial bookmaker known for streaming thousands of amateur sports events from undisclosed locations, has been implicated in facilitating betting on games featuring minors, with investigations revealing a network of matches in Russia, Ukraine, and Belarus. Despite being blacklisted in several countries and facing legal issues, 1xBet continues to partner with prominent football clubs like FC Barcelona and Paris Saint-Germain, highlighting the complex landscape of online gambling and its connections to unregulated amateur sports.

Web of crime exposed: 5,100 arrests in illegal football gambling crackdown

INTERPOL'S Operation SOGA X, an international crackdown on illegal football gambling, led to over 5,100 arrests and the recovery of more than USD 59 million in illicit proceeds across 28 countries, particularly during the UEFA 2024 European Championship. The operation not only targeted illegal betting sites but also uncovered human trafficking schemes, dismantled organized crime networks, and highlighted the close ties between illegal gambling, money laundering, and match-fixing activities.
