TEXT OF THE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the traffic in cocaine is increasing and the chewing of the coca-leaf is a continuing problem,

WHEREAS the increased use of such drugs creates most serious problems in all countries affected,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Helsinki from 21st to 28th August 1963 at its 32nd session:

RESOLVES that:

- (1) Such member countries where the coca-leaf is grown make every effort to reduce the production and growth to that necessary amount needed for medicinal, scientific and commercial use as a flavouring extract;
- (2) All member countries use their good offices to stimulate co-operation and take such effective measures as are necessary toward the curtailment of this illicit traffic.
