TEXT OF RESOLUTION

HAVING HAD a useful discussion of the subject of systems of building up a visual likeness of a person from descriptions given by a victim or witness to a crime by the use of a series of especially prepared transparencies or photographic slides,

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Madrid from 19th to 26th September 1962 at its 31st session:

RESOLVES that:

- (1) Such systems may prove an aid in investigations and in solving crimes,
- (2) The advisability of using any such systems should be decided by each member country on an individual basis for use within that particular country,
- (3) Each member country should be encouraged to keep the Secretary General informed of any interesting developments in this field for the benefit of the members at large.
