## TEXT OF RESOLUTION

The ICPO-Interpol General Assembly, meeting in Madrid from 19th to 26th September 1962 at its 31st session:

DECIDES that the articles of the Constitution and the General Regulations mentioned below shall be changed as follows.

## CONSTITUTION

Article 35.- The role of Advisers shall be purely advisory.

Article 36.- Advisers shall be appointed for three years by the Executive Committee. Their appointment shall become definite only after approval by the General Assembly.

They shall be chosen from among those who have a world-wide reputation in some field of interest to the Organization.

## GENERAL REGULATIONS

Article 46.- Advisers may be individually or collectively consulted on the initiative of the Assembly, the Executive Committee, the President or the Secretary General. They may make suggestions of a scientific nature to the General Secretariat or the Executive Committee.

Article 50.- The advisers may meet when convened by the President of the Organization.
